Given the nickname « the Bad Boy » of Saint-Emilion by Robert Parker, Jean-Luc Thunevin has managed throughout his career to become little by little a central figure of the exclusive Bordeaux wine industry.

In 1988, Jean Luc Thunevin created his own wine merchant company THUNEVIN SAS, which handles the distribution of Jean Luc Thunevin's wines from Bordeaux (incl. Ch Valandraud 1st GCC) and the Roussillon. It also carries a large range of carefully selected wines from Bordeaux sold in exclusivity as well as the major Bordeaux Classified Growths.



This property in appellation Bordeaux was taken up by the actual owner Paul Marie Morillon in 1993. He takes care of its vineyard like a garden, and his vines are cultivated in terraces, not so far from Saint-Emilion.

Technical Informations

Soils : clay limestone

Grapes : Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec

Production: Natural grass growing, cold pre-fermentation maceration

Tasting Notes: Dark plum/ruby-colored offering reveals copious quantities of sweet, nearly over-ripe black cherry fruit, low acidity, a succulent texture, medium body, and a clean, lush finish

Ageing : Stainless steel vats
